

## **TLILIC0010 Licence to operate a slewing mobile crane (up to 20 tonnes)**

A slewing mobile crane means a mobile crane incorporating a boom jib that is capable of being slewed.

### **This excludes:**

Loaders, backhoes, excavator and other earthmoving machinery when configured for lifting operations.

**Note:** a C2 licence incorporates CN and CV classes

If a slewing telehandler is fitted with a boom and/or jib with a hoist rope and/or hook block, a C2, C6, C1, C0

### **Requirements**

- Participants must wear steel capped footwear. STO can provide Hi Visibility Clothing and Hard Hats. For any specific PPE requirements please contact STO
- Participants must provide 100 points of Identity and be a minimum of 18 years of age. Please see evidence of identity form
- English language skills need to be sufficient to understand and comprehend written and verbal instructions
- Numeracy skills are needed to interpret calculations and formulas

### **Content**

- WHS Act, regulations, AS, Codes or practice
- Plan work
- Conduct routine checks
- Correctly interpret load charts
- Communication
- Set up, configure and operate a slewing crane safely
- Safely shift load
- Shut down and secure crane

### **Certification**

On successful completion of this course, participants will be issued with a Notice of Satisfactory Assessment for **Licence to operate a slewing mobile crane up to 20t – TLILIC 0010** by a **Safe Work NSW Accredited Assessor**

### **HRWL Application**

Participants have 60 days to process their Notice of Satisfactory at a NSW post office, also a passport photo will need to be provided
