Dozer operations covers dozer operations in the civil construction industry.

It includes:

- Planning and preparing
- Conducting machine pre-operational checks
- Stripping, spreading material
- Operation of dozer
- Cut and fill
- Battering, stockpiling, cutting drains
- Benching, backfilling
- Relocating the machine and carrying out Operator maintenance and clean up

Requirements

- English language skills need to be sufficient to understand and comprehend written and verbal instructions
- Numeracy skills are needed to interpret calculations and formulas
